

Swimming Pool Use

This pool is for the use of East Shores Owners/Renters and their accompanied guests only

Pool Hours:

7:00 AM – 10:00 PM

Closed every Monday at 7:30 PM for chemical treatment

NO RUNNING

NO DIVING

NO: bicycles, skates, skateboards, rollerblades, or animals allowed inside the pool or court area
(exceptions: trained service animals, see below)

Personal items are not to be left at the pool, they will be locked up; call the board to retrieve your belongings
Children should not use the swimming pool without adult supervision.

Adults should not swim alone.

No lifeguards are provided by ESOA at anytime. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

Furniture moving is frowned upon. If you move it, put it back where it belongs!

All bathers, before entering the swimming pool, shall be required to take a cleansing shower.

Persons having or reasonably suspected to have any considerable area of exposed sub-epidermal tissue, cuts, or known or recognizable contagious or communicable diseases, cough, cold, open sore, blisters, bandaged wound, fever, inflammation of the eyes, nasal or ear discharges shall not be allowed to enter the pool water.

All animals with the exception of trained service animals shall be prohibited within the pool fence, pool room or bathhouse facilities. Trained service animals are those that have been trained to provide assistance, or perform tasks that benefit persons with a disability, or provide emotional support to alleviate a symptom or effect of a disability. Trained service animals are permitted in the pool area, but not in the pool (per NC health code). Service dogs must remain with handler and handler must maintain control of service animal at all times.

Spitting, urinating, blowing of the nose, spouting of water or depositing foreign matter in the pool shall be strictly prohibited.

Bottles, crockery, glass containers or other hazardous objects shall not be permitted within the pool fence area, pool room, bathhouse facilities or in the swimming pool or on the deck area.

No person shall bring or throw into the pool, or on its floors, walkways, aisles or dressing rooms any object that may in any way carry contamination or endanger the safety of any bather.

Individuals who are not toilet trained are required to use waterproof pants or diapers in the pool.

Any person suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be prohibited from the pool area.

Consumption of food and or beverages and use of tobacco products shall not be permitted in the swimming pool or on the deck area.

No diving is permitted off the deck anywhere into the pool.

Respect others using the pool/clubhouse.

Guest policy: The pool/club is only for the use of East Shores owners/residents and their guests, accompanied by a resident.

Pool parties: Contact the Board. The pool can not be reserved for just your party; others will be allowed to use the pool.

Pool keys: Pool keys should be in the possession of East Shores owners/residents only and are not to be given to guests. It is the responsibility of the seller to hand the pool key over to a new owner so new owners do not have to purchase a new key.
